

## Lake County Commissioners in Action

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**LAKE COUNTY** - Lake County Commissioners Bob Aufuldish, Dan Troy and Ray Sines meet at 10 a.m. most Thursdays, with some meetings at 2 p.m. on Tuesdays, in the Commissioners' Chambers on the fourth floor of the Lake County Administration Building, 105 Main St., Painesville.

There was a meeting Oct. 16. The next meeting will be Thursday, Oct. 25 at 10 a.m.

At the Oct. 11 meeting, the following resolutions were adopted:

### ENGINEER'S DEPARTMENT

- Authorizing James R. Gills, Lake County engineer, to prepare and submit an application for the Ohio Public Works Commission' State Capital Improvement and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program(s), and to execute an OPWC agreement for McMackin Road in Madison Township. This is for the culvert replacement project.

- Finding and determining that the territory to be used by Perry Township trustees for Lake Erie Shore protection to said ODNR specifications along the shoreline of the property at Perry Township park, Perry

Township, is not required for use by Lake County and complies with regulations of permissible land use.

### UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

- Approving change order No. 1 with Fabrizi Trucking & Paving Co., Inc. for Bellflower Area Outlet Sewer Replacement Project No. 329S for the Lake County Department of Utilities, increasing the total contract amount by \$12,051.40.

The change order is for additional asphalt replacement, bringing the contract to a new total cost of \$226,764.40.

- Increasing appropriations for Lake County Department of Utilities Water District Contract Services-Subdivision.

- Increasing appropriations for Lake County Department of Utilities Solid Waste Management Minor Equipment.

- To delete a water sum certified to the Lake County auditor.

- Accepting the retirement resignation of Robyn Needler from her position of operator III with the Lake County Department of Utilities, effective December 31.

- Certifying unpaid sewer and water sums to the Lake County auditor.

- Reclassifying Michael R. Martin to the position of system maintenance I in the Lake County Department of Utilities, effective Oct. 22.

- Hiring Matthew Hanusosky to the position of system maintenance I in the Lake County Department of Utilities, effective Nov. 5.

- Hiring Kyle Mullins to the position of system maintenance I in the Lake County Department of Utilities, effective Oct. 22.

- Rick Sands to the position of system maintenance I in the Lake County Department of Utilities, effective Oct. 22.

- Awarding a bid contract to Infinity Paving Company, Inc. for Stirling Road Pavement Repair Project 337S in the amount of \$38,825.

The engineer's estimate was \$65,000 and the highest bid was \$47,025.

### JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES DEPARTMENT

- Appointing Ashley E. Hibbard to the position of income maintenance worker 3 in the Income Maintenance Division of the Lake County Department of Job and Family Services, effective Oct. 22.

### COMMISSIONERS OFFICE

- Designating Jason Boyd as certifying officer and David Radachy and Rhea Benton as environmental officers in accordance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development rules governing the use of funds under the Community Development Block Grant and HOME programs.

"This resolution is a standard HUD document. Each year, when the county receives the funds, we are required to do a number of environmental reviews based on the significance of the initiative," said, Boyd, the county administrator.

The resolution gives

Radachy and Benton authorization to prepare and sign the documents for approval by Boyd.

- Authorizing execution of a subrecipient agreement between the Lake County Board of Commissioners and Shaniuk and Associates, LLC for the Housing Stability Program (HSP) in the amount of \$6,000.

- Authorizing execution of a three-year service agreement between the Lake County Board of Commissioners and Central Exterminating co. for pest control services.

- Authorizing execution of a memorandum of understanding between the Lake County Board of Commissioners, on behalf of the Lake County Law Library Resources Board, and the statewide consortium of County Law Library Resources Boards to accept grant funding, effective Jan. 1, 2013 through June 30, 2013.

### FINANCE

#### DEPARTMENT

- Approving payment of bills in the amount of \$821,724.09.

- Approving purchase orders in the amount of \$346,385.05.

- Increasing appropriations for various non general fund accounts.

- Transferring appropriations within various general and non general fund accounts.
