



TIPS: Disposing of Pharmaceuticals

The Lake County General Health District and Solid Waste District administer the Pharmaceutical Drug Collection & Disposal Program. This program allows residents to remove controlled substances from medicine cabinets in a swift timeframe, thereby reducing confusion, abuse, and the disposal of unwanted drugs down the toilet or in the trash. All pharmaceutical drugs collected in these bins will be destroyed safely by incineration.

WARNING, DO NOT BRING: Mail Orders, Needles, or Syringes

NOTE: Remove or black out personal information on the pharmacy label, otherwise leave in the original package/container

What to Drop Off: Pharmaceutical Drugs Only

- Unused Medications
- Expired Medications
- Prescription Pills
- Non-Prescription Pills
- Syrups
- Creams
- Pain Relievers
- Cold/Flu Medicine
- Vitamins
- Pet Medications
