PRESS RELEASE January 30, 2013

Lt. Carl Dondorfer reported that on January 29th, 2013 at 12:45 pm, the Lake County Sheriff's Office responded to an address on Johnnycake Ridge Road in Concord Township for a reported *Burglary* in progress. The 43 year old female resident was awakened to find two male burglars in her home, one of which was in her bedroom at the time she was sleeping. The burglars had made forcibly into the home by breaking out a rear door window.

Upon startling the resident and being confronted the burglars fled the scene north through a wooded area. Patrol Deputies responded to the scene and set up a perimeter. Sgt. Larry Harpster located two male subjects walking in the 200 block of Fairgrounds' Road, a short distance from the crime scene. The males were identified as a 27 year old Ryan Arkenburg on Painesville and a 19 year old Nicholas Zundel from Painesville Twp.

Subsequent investigation by deputies on scene determined that these were in fact the two suspects who had burglarized the Concord Township home. The suspects had changed their clothing in a wooded area after fleeing the scene. The clothing was later recovered along with other relevant evidence linking both suspects to the crime. Both suspects later made a full disclosure regarding their involvement in this crime.

Both Arkenburg and Zundel were arrested, charged with *Aggravated Burglary*, and incarcerated in the Lake County Adult Detention Facility. They will be arraigned in Painesville Municipal Court today.
