Potassium Iodide

What is Potassium Iodide (KI)?

Radioactive Iodine (radioiodine) is one of the products that could be released in a serious nuclear accident. Potassium Iodide (KI) is a stable form of iodine. It can be taken to saturate the thyroid gland, thus reducing the gland's ability to absorb radioactive iodine. **KI should be taken during an emergency ONLY if recommended by governmental officials. KI is most effective if taken within 3-4 hours of exposure.** KI is available to persons within 10 miles of the Perry Nuclear Power Plant through the county health district. Special Needs Cards

Enclosed with this letter is a Special Needs Card. This card is very important in helping us successfully assist you should an emergency occur. The Special Needs Card is for anyone who would need special help during an evacuation because of physical impairment or special medical problems. If this card applies to you, you should fill it out and return it to us. This information will be kept on file at your County Emergency Management Agency/Department of Emergency Services center. We request that residents submit a new card every year.

This information will be kept confidential. If you wish, complete and sign the card, turn the completed portion of the card to the inside, and tape the card shut. The card will require a stamp prior to mailing.

You are receiving this letter because you are located within 10 miles of the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. Your County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) wants to make you aware of important changes to the *FirstEnergy Emergency Preparedness Information* brochure you received in 2011. Attached, please find **specific changes** that have occurred, including the **Receiving Schools and Pick-Up Points in your area**. Information regarding how you can pick up your free Potassium Iodide (KI) and Special Needs Cards has also been included.

This letter should be kept with the brochure until you receive a new one in 2014. If you no longer have a copy of your brochure, an electronic copy can be downloaded and/or printed via a link from your local EMA's website.

Your local telephone directory contains a section that describes how to prepare for and what actions you should take in the event of an emergency at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. This and other preparedness information is also available on your local EMA's website.

Please take a few minutes to review this important information with family members and co-workers. Remember that the best way to stay safe in an emergency is to know what to do. If you have additional questions, please contact your local Emergency Management Agency.
