PERFORMANCE EVALUATION REPORT (CAPER)
FISCAL YEAR 2014

The FY'14 CAPER is a statement of how Lake County used the federal allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) Program funds during the FY'14 program year (10/01/14 to 9/30/15). To the extent required by HUD the CAPER includes activities funded through Ohio Homeless Planning Region 5. The FY'14 Grantee Performance Evaluation Report provides a concise description of each CDBG/HOME activity for which funds were budgeted and expended during the FY'14 program year. The CAPER includes cumulative activity and project level accomplishment data derived from beneficiary households.

Lake County attests that CDBG and HOME funds have been used properly and in accordance with HUD regulations. For CDBG, the objectives were met and specified in the final statement for the FY'14 program year to exclusively benefit to either: low and moderate income persons, to aid in the prevention of slums or blight, or to meet community development needs having a particular urgency. Lake County, also, attests that it has complied with its certification to expend not less than 70% of its CDBG funds during the specified period on activities which benefit low and moderate income persons. For HOME, the directives to create and or provide affordable housing opportunities for income eligible households was met.

The Board of Lake County Commissioners will receive comments regarding the FY'14 CAPER until December 21, 2015.
