An additional tax for the benefit of Painesville City for the purpose of providing and maintaining motor vehicles, communications, other equipment, buildings, and sites for such buildings uses directly in the operation of the police department at a rate not exceeding 1.27 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 12.7 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2013, first due in calendar year 2014.

An additional tax for the benefit of Painesville City for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the purchase of ambulance equipment, or the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department at a rate not exceeding 1.47 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 14.7 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2013, first due in calendar year 2014.

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall Article II, Section 5 of the Charter of the City of Painesville be amended to require Councilpersons be nominated by petition signed by not less than fifty (50) registered electors of the City for at-large Councilpersons or not less than twenty-five (25) registered electors residing in the ward being sought for Ward Councilperson and their names shall appear on a nonpartisan ballot without party designation. The nomination of each candidate shall be made by a separate petition, but such petition may be circulated in separate parts, which shall be filed with the Board of Elections as one (1) instrument ninety (90) days prior to the date of holding the regular municipal election?
