A replacement of a tax for the benefit of the Lake County Community College District (Lakeland Community College) for the purpose of providing for the acquisition of sites, the erection, furnishing, and equipment of buildings, the acquisition, construction or improvement of any property which the board of trustees of a community college district is authorized to acquire, construct, or improve and which has an estimated life of usefulness of five years or more as certified by the fiscal officer, and the payment of operating costs of said district at a rate not exceeding 1.7 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 17 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in tax year 2010, first due in calendar year 2011.
