DESCRIPTION OF LAND

Situated in the City of Painesville, County of Lake, and State of Ohio, and known as being part of the George Williams Lot in Tract No. 3 in said City, and bounded and described as follows.

Beginning at a point in the northwesterly line of Nebraska Street, said point being the most easterly corner of land now or formerly owned by Frank W. Loomis;

Thence along said northwesterly line of Nebraska Street, North 28° 30' East, a distance of 50.04 feet to an iron pipe stake at the most southerly corner of land now or formerly owned by A. C. Hine;

Thence along the southwesterly line of land of said Hine, North 59° 11' West, a distance of 275.15 feet to an iron pin at the most easterly corner of land now or formerly owned by Mary Harvey,

Thence along the southeasterly line of land of said Harvey, South 30° 58' West, a distance of 51.10 feet to an iron pin in the northeasterly line of land now or formerly owned by George V. and Rose Zack;

Thence along the northeasterly line of land of said Zack and Loomis, South 59° 24' 30" East (277.21 feet passing through an iron bolt), a distance of 277.30 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 0.321 of an acre of land, according to the survey made by Crabbs and Fullerton, May 29, 1928, be the same more or less, but subject to all legal highways
