### SNOW PARKING BAN IN EFFECT

Painesville, Ohio: A Snow Parking Ban is In Effect for the City of Painesville. Citizens are reminded that when snow accumulation reaches 2 inches or more on a City street, the snow emergency parking ban automatically goes into effect. Residents must move their vehicles off the street. Once the street is plowed, and snow accumulation is less than 2 inches on the street, the ban is automatically lifted. Residents are asked to honor the parking ban regulation, or risk having their vehicle towed. If the vehicles remain on the street they may be ticketed or towed to allow the City's Public Works trucks to clear the street.

Also remember during heavy snow events we ask residents to adopt the fire hydrant located near their property. Keeping the hydrants clear of snow will help the Fire Department respond in times of emergency. Please help make keep our community safe and adopt a fire hydrant!!

Our able-bodied residents are also reminded to look out for your elderly or impaired neighbors and family members by helping them to keep their driveways and sidewalks clear. Helping our neighbors is what makes Painesville a wonderful place to live.
