## JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES DEPARTMENT

Lake County Board of Commissioners, on behalf of the Lake County Department of Job and Family Services, and the Lake County Captains to provide a "Family Of the Game" promotion and a game day program and pocket schedule advertisement, effective March 1.

LCJFS Director Matt Battiato said he thought this was the fourth year for the promotion.

"They recognize one of our foster or adoptive families at 15 of their games," he said. Also, on their scoreboard, they show a picture of a child that's available for adoption and give a brief biography of that child.

The Captains' pocket schedule and program also have advertisements for the county's foster/adoption program along with the child abuse hotline. The special day also allows the foster/adoptive families to have their photo taken with a player.
