ACCEPTED ITEMS INCLUDE:

- Household cleaners & solvents: thinners, kerosene, turpentine, lighter fluid, strippers
- Automotive fluids: used motor oil, gasoline, coolants, antifreeze, grease
- Oil-based paints, varnish, shellacs, stains, aerosols, polyurethanes, primers, grout
- Liquid/solid: pool, lawn & garden chemicals, pesticides, weed killers, spray insecticides
- Batteries - all sizes (including lead acid & household), fluorescent bulbs
- Photography, "hobby" chemicals, mercury, empty propane tanks
- Roofing tars, drive sealers, adhesives

NOT ACCEPTED:

Radioactive (smoke alarms), ammunition, explosives, or medical waste (prescription medications, needles, etc.)

GUIDELINES:

- Leave product in original container if possible, or label contents if known.
- Bring materials only during the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on this date.
- This Household Hazardous Waste Collection is for Lake County residents ONLY.
- Items from businesses CANNOT be accepted.
- Your vehicle will be unloaded by technicians.
- *This collection will take place regardless of weather conditions.*
