At the Oct. 16 meeting, the following resolutions were adopted:

### ENGINEER'S DEPARTMENT

- Authorizing Change Order No. 1 - final payment to Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the various county roads - Bacon Road and Blackbrook Road Contract, OPWC #CG-299.

The original contract amount was \$612,714. Following the change order reduction of \$38,459.13, the new total is \$574,254.87.

### UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

- Awarding a bid contract to HD Supply Waterworks, Ltd. for cold water meters.

• Authorizing the Lake County sanitary engineer to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement Program and to execute contracts as required for Glyco I Phase II Force Main Replacement Project No. 346-S in Painesville Township.

### JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES DEPARTMENT

### COMMISSIONERS OFFICE

- Authorizing execution of a memorandum of understanding by and between the Lake County Board of Commissioners and the Village of

Madison for stormwater services.

- Setting the date, time and place for a public hearing to consider proposed revisions to the Lake County Subdivision regulations.
