LAKE COUNTY - Lake County Commissioners Bob Aufuldish, Dan Troy and Ray Sines meet at 10 a.m. most Thursdays, with some meetings at 2 p.m. on Tuesdays, in the Commissioners' Chambers on the fourth floor of the Lake County Administration Building, 105 Main St., Painesville.

All meetings are open to the public. Requests to address the government board may be made at any board meeting or presented to the Commissioners' Office by calling Amy Elszasz at (440) 350-2753.

There was a meeting May 10. The next meeting will be Thursday, May 24 at 10 a.m.

At the May 1 meeting, the following legislation was adopted:

RESOLUTIONS: ENGINEER'S DEPARTMENT

- Resolution awarding a bid contract to Osborne Concrete & Stone Co. for roadway materials as required by the Lake County Engineer in the amount of \$78,175 for limestone and \$101,875 for plant mix pavement.

- Resolution authorizing the Lake County Board of Commissioners to pursue federal LBR (Local Bridge Program) Funding for the removal of St. Clair Street Bridge in Willoughby.

Since the bridge has been found "structurally deficient and functionally obsolete" it will be removed and will not be replaced.

UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

- Resolution approving change order No. 4 with JTO, Inc. for Kirtland Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project No. 284-S, contracts 2A & 2B for the Lake County Department of Utilities, decreasing the total contract amount by \$13,050.26.

- Resolution transferring cash from LCDU Sewer District transfer out to various general obligation bond retirement funds transfer in.

- Resolution transferring appropriations from 174 and 84 Booster Station Upgrade 326w Contract Projects to professional services-consultants.

- Resolution transferring appropriations within LCDU Solid Waste District.

- Resolution certifying unpaid sewer and water sums to the Lake County Auditor.

JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES DEPARTMENT

- Resolution proclaiming May 2012 Foster Parent Recognition Month in Lake County.

- Resolution approving a budget amendment to the memorandum of understanding between the Lake County Board of Commissioners, Lake County Workforce Investment Board, and One-Stop System Partners for participation in the Lake County One-Stop Service delivery system under the Workforce Investment Act for the time period of July 1 through June 30, 2013, and authorizing the president of the board to execute said memorandum of understanding.

COMMISSIONERS' OFFICE

- Resolution appointing Lake County commissioners Daniel P. Troy and Robert E. Aufuldish to serve on the Ohio Public Works Commission District 7 integrating committee for three-year terms commencing May 22 and designating alternates to serve on their behalf.

- Resolution declaring an unused parcel of real property known as 16D111A000310 located at Lake Overlook Drive, Mentor is no longer needed for public use in accordance with Section 307.09 of the Ohio Revised Code and authorizing the transfer of said property to the high bidder John L. Habe III in consideration of the amount of

\$2,525.

"This is actually 0.11 acres of land," said Commissioner Bob Aufuldish. "We got a pretty nice bid for 0.11 acres."

- Resolution increasing appropriations for various non general fund accounts.

- Resolution transferring cash within various general and non general fund accounts.
