County workers are honored for service

LAKE COUNTY — The Lake County commissioners, Ray Sines, Bob Aufuldish and Dan Troy recognized a number of county workers for their years of service at the Nov. 29 Commissioners' meeting.

Telecommunications Department Director Paul Stefanko was the first to be acknowledged and presented with a resolution and watch.

"You joined our family on July 21, 1986 and you served with integrity during your 27-year tenure and we extend our genuine gratitude for the diligence and dedication you've demonstrated on behalf of Lake County," Troy read from the resolution.

Tom Hilscher, also of the Telecommunications Department, was honored for serving the county for 26 years.

Sines said Hilscher was the one who had to deal with

the calls about problems with the phone service.

Karen Orris, who has resigned her position, was acknowledged for her 14 years with the Telecommunications Department.

"I wasn't expecting this; I just wanted to hear you say I got to leave," she said, instigating much laughter from the crowd.

Betty Stone, who is leaving, had served in the Department of Job and Family Services for 31 years.

She was presented with a resolution and gift by LCDJFS Director Matt Battiato. She began as a case worker and in recent years has been a supervisor.

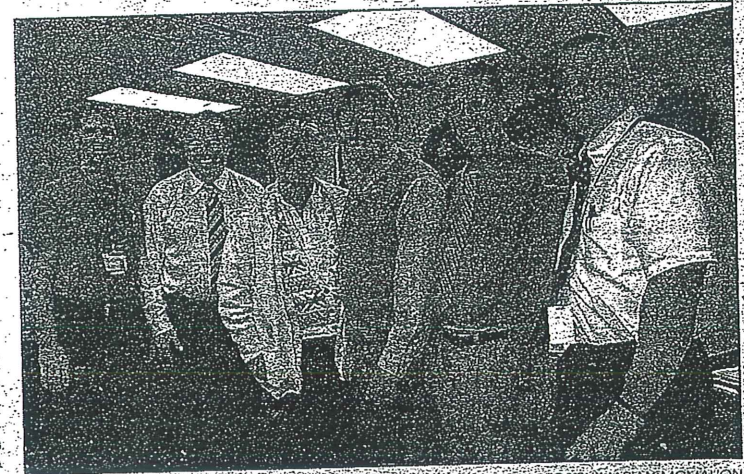
"She is awesome with customer assistance and, as you might imagine, sometimes we have difficult situations with people who come to our agency," Battiato said.

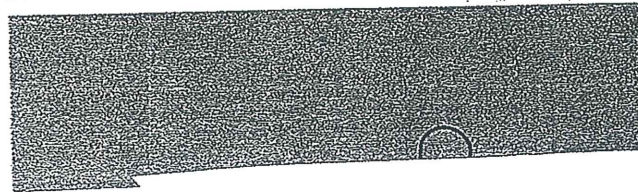
"Both started a number of years ago as operators and worked their way up in the system," Martin said. "Jay started with Buildings and Grounds, actually and then transferred in to our department."

Unable to attend for his award for 25 years was Mike Sullivan, supervisor at the Gary L. Kron Plant.

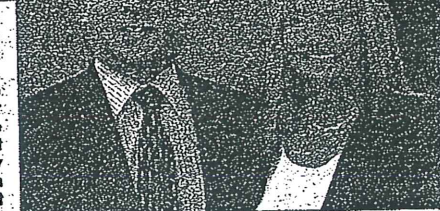
