

Dispose of prescription meds properly

PAINESVILLE - Lake County residents can bring their unwanted and expired prescriptions, cold/flu medications, pain relievers, pet medications, vitamins, creams, cough syrups, pills, and prescription pain medications, to seven area police departments.

Residents should remove or black out the personal information on pharmacy labels

and leave the medicines in the original package or container.

Absolutely no needles or syringes are permissible in the drop off bins. All pharmaceutical drugs collected in these bins will be destroyed by incineration.
