Household waste to be collected

PAINESVILLE - The household hazardous waste collection date is Sept. 29 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Lake County Fairgrounds in Painesville.

Acceptable items include: oil-based paints and other paint related products such as turpentine and thinners; car-maintenance fluids, including oils, grease, gasoline (as well as diesel fuel and kerosene), anti-freeze and coolants; old cleaning solvents (acids/bases/oxidizers); lawn chemicals and

pesticides (liquid and solid); batteries of all sizes including vehicle lead acid batteries; mercury-containing items such as thermometers; "hobby" chemicals, reactives; aerosols; fluorescent light bulbs; grill-sized propane tanks.

Do not bring latex paint, medical waste, explosives, ammunition, or radioactive materials.
