

## Lake County Commissioners in Action

**LAKE COUNTY** - Lake County Commissioners Bob Aufuldis, Dan Troy and Judy Moran met at 10 a.m. most Thursdays, with some meetings at 2 p.m. on Tuesdays, in the Commissioners' Chambers on the fourth floor of the Lake County Administration Building, 105 Main St., Painesville.

All meetings are open to the public. Requests to address the government board may be made at any board meeting or presented to the Commissioners' Office by calling Amy Elasz at (440) 350-2753.

There was a meeting June 4. The next meeting will be Tuesday, June 11 at 10 a.m.

At the June 4 meeting, the following resolutions were adopted:

**ENGINEER'S DEPARTMENT**

- Accepting a temporary

easement for the Vrooman Road Roundabout Project in Leroy Township.

### COMMISSIONERS' OFFICE

- Authorizing execution of an agreement on behalf of the Lake County Sheriff's Office-Central Communications Division, and Security, Government and Infrastructure, a Division of Intergraph Corporation, for an I/CAD and I/MOBILE to MPS upgrade and an V/FSA interface to Motorola.

"It's simply a technology upgrade that we have to do every so often. The last one was done about six years ago," said Major Charles Caldwell, who heads Central Communications Division.

- Accepting an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Nonpoint Source Implementation Grant in the amount of \$100,000 on behalf of the Lake County Stormwater Management Department and authorizing execution of the grant agree-

ment, effective June 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014.

"This is a grant from Ohio EPA, called a 319 grant; it will allow us to retrofit portions of the administration parking lot with stormwater best management practices that will include porous pavement and infiltration trenches," said Tim Miller, director of the Lake County Stormwater Management Department.

- Authorizing execution of the FY 2014 RECLAIM Ohio and Youth Services Subsidy Grant Agreement and funding application between the Lake County Board of Commissioners on behalf of the Lake County Juvenile Court and the Ohio Department of Youth Services for youth programs, care, and services.

The amount of the grant requested is \$1,895,514.

"This is a program started a long time ago by the state; it actually rewards counties that do no incarcer-

ate their juveniles in the Department of Youth Services but deal with them on a more local basis and as a result of that, Lake County Juvenile court has done a very good job of that and are able to receive these funds," said Commissioner Dan Troy.

### FINANCE DEPARTMENT

- Approving payment of bills in the amount of \$2,401,505.39.

- Approving purchase orders in the amount of \$835,691.22.

- Increasing appropriations for various non-general fund accounts.

- Transferring cash and appropriations within various general and non-general fund accounts.

### EXECUTIVE SESSION

The commissioners adjourned to executive session to discuss imminent litigation and collective bargaining.
