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LAKE COUNTY - Lake County Commissioners Bob Aufuldish, Dan Troy and Ray Sines meet at 10 a.m. most Thursdays, with some meetings at 2 p.m. on Tuesdays, in the Commissioners' Chambers on the fourth floor of the Lake County Administration Building, 105 Main St., Painesville.

There was a meeting Oct. 11. The next meeting will be Tuesday, Oct. 16 at 2 p.m.

At the Oct. 4 meeting, the following resolutions were adopted:

ENGINEER'S DEPARTMENT

- Authorizing change order No. 1 and pay applica-

tion No. 2 to Huffman Equipment Rental & Contracting Inc. for the LAK-Leroy Thompson Road Bridge replacement Project Contract.

The initial contract amount was \$339,133.35. With the change order amount of \$1,396.22 it increases to \$340,529.57.

LCDU is retaining \$13,565.33 until the stormwater post construction best management practices (BMPs) can be removed in a couple months.

- Authorizing change order No. 1 and pay application No. 9 final to Karvo Paving Co. for the LAK-Lake Road West Improvement Project Contract.

- The current contract amount is \$2,242,833.40. With the change order amount of \$198,399.26 the final is \$2,044,434.14.

UTILITIES DEPARTMENT

- Authorizing execution of an agreement with Environmental Engineering And Technology, Inc.

The \$15,000 is for esti-

mated engineering fees to look into replacement of the filter media at the Aquarius Water Treatment Plant.

- Increasing appropriations in various Madison Waste Water Treatment Plant and Expansion accounts.

- Increasing appropriations for various LCDU Sewer Fund and Glyco II Lift Station Rehab accounts and transferring cash.

- Awarding a bid contract to V & T Painting LLC for White Road 750,000-Gallon Water Tank Painting Project in the amount of \$309,000.

- The bids went to a high of \$759,400. The engineer's estimate was \$470,000.

JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES

- Approving Lake County Department of Job and Family Services vouchers date of warrant Oct. 9 in the amount of \$158,937.34.

The breakdown of charges was: Public Assistance - \$21,927.58; Workforce Investment - \$75,906.14; Child Support

Enforcement - \$78.18; and Child Welfare - \$61,025.14.

COMMISSIONERS OFFICE

- Authorizing acceptance of a VOCA grant in the amount of \$130,250 and a SVAA grant in the amount of \$13,823 from the office of the Ohio Attorney General under the Ohio Crime Victims Assistance Grant Program for the Lake County Prosecutor's Assistance Program, effective Oct. 1 through Sept. 30, 2013.

- Approving payment of bills in the amount of \$1,578,703.01.

- Approving purchase orders in the amount of \$323,725.43.

- Increasing appropriations for various non general fund accounts.

- Transferring cash and appropriations within general and non general fund accounts.

The commissioners adjourned to executive session to discuss personnel compensation.
