LAKE COUNTY – The new county websites have been unveiled with improved functionality, appearance and navigation.

After a lengthy process of review and coordination with county officials and department supervisors to assess the needs, preferences and content each office required, a Website Committee composed of County Administrator Jason Boyd, the special project coordinator and Information Technology staff,

developed a request of proposals and evaluated candidates based on the county survey.

The new county homepage, as well as many of the individual county public office homepages, now will enjoy a clean, easy-on-the-eye readability, a consistent appearance across sites, increased accessibility to data, regularly updated information, a county calendar listing public meetings and events, breaking news and

alerts, and downloadable electronic forms.

The site also includes "County Quick Links" to the six most visited web pages in the County and an interactive map featuring county office locations.

The county has included many links on the new website to other local, state and federal public offices, social service agencies, schools and libraries, economic development resources, senior citizens cen-

ters, parks and recreation, and tourism opportunities.
