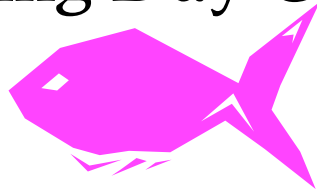

# “Hooked on Fishing – Not on Drugs” Fishing Day Camp



Two opportunities: June 10-14 and July 15-19, 2013

9 am to 3 pm

Wildlife Center at Penitentiary Glen Reservation

This camp is an adaptation of the Hooked on Fishing – Not on Drugs program, which is a registered trademark of the Future Fisherman Foundation. This national program uses angling skill development as a gateway to teach youth about the benefits of a healthy lifestyle and how to deal with the challenges facing them in their young lives. The activities and lessons are designed to enable the young participants to become ethical anglers and also to grow into adults that will make wise decisions for themselves and the environment.

In addition to fishing, the participants will learn to rig their own gear, equipment choices and casting, fish identification and ecology, aquatic habitats, fishing regulations and ethics, the effects of pollution, respect for one's self and others, and many other life skills all proving that fishing is a wholesome activity that can be accomplished with family or friends without the use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. Children will have classroom instruction, crafts, games and activities, and daily fishing opportunities. No fishing equipment or experience needed!
