- B. Look for “targets” created by the likely victim. Good at developing *friendships*. May target users online, lying about his/her own identity and age.
- C. The identification number of your computer or cell phone that allows you to be tracked.
- D. An identity that you knowingly create about yourself online that is positive and caring.
- E. Used to keep unauthorized persons out of our files, settings, and *private* information.
- F. Small file that is dropped onto your computer by some web sites to store/collect information without your knowledge.
- G. Domain used by schools, colleges, and universities.
- H. Digital storage device to hold files, photos, videos, and music.
- I. Domain used by government agencies.
- J. A way to move quickly, with a single mouse click, from one place to another on the Net. Can be dangerous to the security of your computer.
- K. Sending or posting harmful or hurtful text or images using the InterNet or other communication devices.
- L. Service that offers direct access to the InterNet and usually requires a monthly fee.
