Our YLP (Youth Led Prevention) teens will help with face-painting; food handouts; will have an opportunity to chat and socialize; will serve as healthy role models; and have plenty of opportunity to show the community that teens are about having a safe summer by making good, healthy choices. You will receive lunch, bottled water, and a *Certificate of Community Service* for the hours you volunteer.

Since the Convoy of Hope, a nonprofit organization, was founded in 1994 they have served more than 40 million people throughout the world through international children's feeding initiatives, community outreaches, disaster response and partner resourcing. Lake County's Youth Led Prevention has a wonderful opportunity to partner with Convoy of Hope in serving the children of Lake County.

- You must be a high school student 10th-12th grade. (*entering 10th grade is okay*)
- You have several schedule choices: *Please advise Officer Willis your choice.*
 - Whole day 12 – 6
 - 3 hour shift 12–3 or 1– 4 or 2– 5 or 3 – 6
- A Certificate of Community Service will be awarded for your volunteerism.
- Transportation to and from the fairgrounds is on your own.
- Face-painting supplies will be provided.
