Staff from the State of Ohio's Ohio Geographically Referenced Information Program (OGRIP) will present on the Ohio Spatial Data Infrastructure initiative. The OGRIP Council is requesting your participation as a user of Ohio geospatial data and technology to help craft a strategic plan to guide the development of Ohio's Spatial Data Infrastructure (OSDI). Your participation will help OGRIP prioritize the implementation of data development initiatives and GIS support services necessary to promote enterprise data sharing partnerships and capabilities among all levels of government and the private sector.

As part of the OGRIP Statewide GIS plan initiative, 5 regional meetings will occur across the state. These meetings will present the results of the recent GIS strategic planning survey, allow participants to ask additional questions or provide comments about their responses, allow for discussion of items not covered by the survey or that arose from the questions and provide next steps in the strategic planning process.
