Presentation: Geo-tagging Photos with Trimble technology

How to Geo-tagging Photos with Trimble TerraSync Professional Software.

The technology utilized will be the Trimble Juno 3B, Nomad 900G, Yuma Tablet PC, and the Geo Explorer 6000 XH GPS units for GIS mapping. Discussion will include how to setup a Data Dictionary in Pathfinder Office to allow photos to be captures associated with collecting a point feature. Demonstration will follow teaching how to transfer the data dictionary into the Geo 6000 XH to load into TerraSync Professional software; how to collect a point feature with the GPS unit and then capture a photo inside TerraSync to allow a GPS coordinate to be embedded into the JPEG image. GPS Photo Link software will then allow the Geo-tagged photos to be customized with the attribute labeling for output to PDF, Shapefile, Google Earth KMZ, and MS Word formats.

If time permits, a demonstration will follow on how to geo-tag a time-stamped photo, taken with a standard digital camera, by using the GPS Photo Link software.
