Weapons Call, 411 Peppertree, Reported as Male with a Gun.
04-18-13

At 1831 Hrs., the Lake County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a man with a gun in the area of 411 Peppertree. The male reportedly threatened to shoot a resident at the noted address. Upon arrival, it was learned that the suspect, named as 34yr. old Painesville resident Kenneth Davis, had fled the area driving a four door white Chevy Impala. Deputies were unable to locate the described vehicle in the area. The victim gave deputies rather sketchy information as to why Mr. Davis had made threats and chose not to pursue any type of charges.

At 2011 hrs Deputies were dispatched to the 400 block of the Peppertree Condominium complex again in reference to Mr. Davis returning and possibly still being armed. Deputies, along with Painesville City PD units, surrounded the complex and located Mr. Davis near unit 407. Mr. Davis was detained without incident. Mr. Davis was found to be unarmed and there were no weapons found on his person. Mr. Davis further denied having any weapons now or earlier this date.

Mr. Davis was found to have an active Failure to Appear Warrant on charges of Disorderly Conduct out of the Lake County Sheriff's Office. Mr. Davis was taken into custody on the noted warrant. Mr. Davis was found to have drugs in the form of Marijuana in his pants pocket. Mr. Davis' vehicle was towed subsequent to arrest and during inventory, additional drugs and drug paraphernalia were found. Mr. Davis was booked into the Lake County Sheriff's Office Jail on his active warrant along with charges of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Possession of Marijuana.
