PRESS RELEASE **December 5, 2011**

In response to the rash of burglaries across Lake County in recent months, the Lake County Sheriff's Office will be running a *Reverse 9-1-1* call to residents in Concord Township, Leroy Township, Painesville Township, and Perry Township. The Sheriff's Office is looking for the assistance of community members to report suspicious activity as it occurs in their neighborhoods. The *Reverse 9-1-1* call will state:

"This is the Lake County Sheriff's Office with an important message We are experiencing a rash of daytime burglaries in our neighborhoods. We need your help. Please report any suspicious activity that may include; people knocking on doors, strange vehicles, occupied or unoccupied that you see in your area. If the activity is occurring, call 9-1-1. Otherwise call 350-5620 to speak to a Deputy Sheriff or Detective. Thank you for helping to keep your community safe."

Sometimes people are reluctant to call because they believe they are troubling law enforcement with insignificant information. However, it is important that we are aware of activity such as people coming to your door and looking for someone who does not live there, cars parked that are occupied or unoccupied for long periods of time, or vehicles parked in places that they are not normally seen. We believe that making everyone aware in the area of the daytime burglaries that are occurring will bring additional eyes and ears to the situation, and help in solving these crimes.
