Ref: Pedestrian MVA, Concord Township

On 09/24/2013 at about 9:08pm the Lake County Sheriff's and Concord Township Rescue were dispatched to the intersection of Mountain Quail and Mourning Dove for a pedestrian VS pickup truck injury accident.

Investigation revealed that Chalmers Glover (42 YOA who resides in Concord Township) was operating a 2012 Ford F150 Eastbound on Mountain Quail. Mr. Glover attempted to make a left turn onto Mourning Dove and failed to see John Hetzer (43 YOA who resides in Concord Township) walking a dog on the southbound lane of Mourning Dove. The Ford truck had struck Mr. Hetzer knocking Mr. Hetzer down on to the concrete road surface. Mr. Hetzer's head struck the roadway resulting in injury. Mr. Hetzer was wearing reflective clothing and a red flashing light at the time he was struck.

Mr. Hetzer was transported by Concord Township Fire Department to an awaiting Medivac Helicopter and then to Metro Health Medical Center in Cleveland. The crash remains under investigation. At 11:45pm Mr. Hetzer was reported to be in stable condition.
