

Water Utility Electronic Instrumentation/Maintenance Technician

The Lake County Department of Utilities Water Division is accepting resumes for the entry level position of Electronic Instrumentation/Maintenance Technician. Applicants must have a High School diploma or GED. A valid Ohio Driver's license with a safe driving record and a drug screening are required.

Knowledge of mathematics, electrical/electronic systems and components, 24 volt DC 4-20 mA current loop circuits, quality assurance principles and proper use of hand tools is preferred. Applicants should be familiar with maintenance and repair of pumps, motors, valves, gauges, backflow preventers and regulators. The applicant should have the ability to install, calibrate, troubleshoot, repair, test, and perform preventative maintenance of electronic, electro-mechanical and/or mechanical equipment, use electronic test equipment such as multimeters, 4-20 mA generator, understand computers, generate schematics for new electrical/electronic equipment installations or changes made to current equipment, assist in the design, experimentation, testing and installation of new electrical or electronic equipment, to maintain neat, concise accurate records, effective working relationships with fellow coworkers.

This position will include physical labor, including working outdoors in all types of weather conditions. This position requires emergency call out response at all hours of the day and night including weekends and holidays. Starting salary is \$19.35 per hour.
