

MAINTENANCE – SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION

The Lake County Commissioners are now accepting resumes for the position of Sanitary Sewer Collection System Maintenance for the Lake County Department of Utilities. The candidate will be involved in the installation, maintenance, cleaning and repair of the County's wastewater collection system. A background in collection system maintenance including heavy equipment operation is needed. Experience in sewer cleaning, sewer repair and sewer inspection is desired.
