

LEGAL NOTICE FOR PROPOSALS (TRANSPORTABLE RADIATION PORTAL MONITORS)

Sealed Proposals will be received by the Board of Lake County Commissioners in and for Lake County at their Office in the Lake County Administration Center, 105 Main Street, Painesville, Ohio 44077; up to the hour of 11:00 AM local time on the 7th, day of August, 2013, and will remain sealed until the award of the contract is made pursuant to Section 307.862 of the Revised Code to provide up to ten (10) transportable radiation portal monitors capable of serving the needs of the Lake County public safety forces.

The proposal package and a description of specifications for the Transportable Radiation Portal Monitors can be obtained in the Office of the Board of Lake County Commissioners, 105 Main Street Painesville, Ohio 44077, during weekday business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The Proposal deemed most advantageous to Lake County will be awarded the contract to provide up to ten (10) Transportable Radiation Portal Monitors. The Board reserves the right to reject any and all proposals. Each proposal must contain the full legal name of the person making the proposal and the principal owners if operating as a legal entity with a different name.

Pursuant to R.C. 153.01 et. seq. the original sealed Proposal must be accompanied by a bond, certified check, cashier's check, or money order in the amount of five percent of the full bid amount, payable to the Board of Lake County Commissioners. The bond, certified check, cashier's check, cashier's check, or money order is subject to forfeiture if the proposal is awarded and the contract is not entered into. The proposals must be held open for a period not longer than sixty (60) days after bid opening and the award may take place at any time after bid opening within the sixty (60) day period.

No Offeror shall be considered eligible to be awarded the contract to which this Notice or Specifications apply, if the Offeror is listed on the Auditor of State's Database as having a "Finding of Recovery" as that term is defined in R.C. 9.24.
