LAKE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT FIRE UPDATE

On August 20, 2014, Lake County General Health District (LCGHD) had a fire at its 33 Mill Street location in Painesville, Ohio. There were no injuries and no chemicals were involved. The building will not reopen for four to six months. Restore-X is currently on the site and will secure the building.

Services are currently being relocated:

- Birth and Death Certificates may be obtained at the Health District's temporary relocated offices located in the basement of the Lake County Administration Building.
- Women Infants and Children (WIC) offices located in Willoughby and Madison are open. WIC clients of the Painesville office are being individually contacted. There is a mobile WIC unit that will be located in the LCGHD parking lot on Friday, August 22, 2014 that will take care of Painesville WIC clients.
- The Mosquito Spraying Program will continue as scheduled.
- Anyone in need of vaccinations should contact their healthcare provider or may contact the Geauga County Health District (GCHD). GCHD takes clients on a walk-in basis.
