

## Notice of Public Hearing

A public hearing will be held by the Board of Lake County Commissioners at the Lake County Business & Training Center, 1981 Blase Nemeth Road, Painesville Township, Ohio at 6:00 p.m. on April 13, 2010, when and where objections to, or endorsements of, proposed McMackin Road Water Improvement Project No. 261-W will be heard.

The proposed waterline improvement project begins at the intersection where McMackin Road abuts Chapel Road and extends an existing 12 inch waterline as follows: The waterline continues south along McMackin Road, approximately 1,495.25 feet to a point at the southeast corner of Permanent Parcel Number 01B-124-0-00-003-0 which is the end of the assessed properties.

All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon: The east side of McMackin Road from the northerly line now or formerly owned by Agnes Kraince (Permanent Parcel No. 01B-129-0-00-011-0), southerly to the southerly line of land now or formerly owned by Noel P. Boggs (Permanent Parcel No. 01B-129-0-00-012-0) and the west side of McMackin Road from the northerly line of land now or formerly owned by Robert J. Fritch (Permanent Parcel No. 01B-128-0-00-001-0), southerly to the southerly line of land now or formerly owned by Daniel A. and Barbara K. Nichols (Permanent Parcel No. 01B-124-0-00-003-0).

The project also includes: related appurtenances, fire hydrants, pavement and drive replacement, and site restoration.

The detailed plans, specifications, estimates of costs and tentative assessments are on file in the office of the Lake County Department of Utilities, Lake County Administration Center, Third Floor, 105 Main Street, Painesville, Ohio, and are available for inspection therein.

Written objections to, or endorsements of, the proposed Project No. 261-W, the character and termini thereof, the tentative assessments therefor or the boundaries of the assessment district for the same will be received by the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County for a period of five days after the hearing, and no action shall be taken by that Board in the matter until after such period shall have elapsed.
