USDA Cash Medical Support Schedule

The following basic cash medical support schedule shall be used by all courts and child support enforcement agencies when calculating the amount of cash medical support to be paid pursuant to a child support order in accordance with section 3119.30 of the Revised Code, **unless the annual gross income of the obligor is below one hundred fifty percent of the federal poverty level for an individual.**
