Painesville, OH -

The following is a recap of the November 7, 2017 General Election:
55, 323 voters participated in the General Election representing a 35.44% turnout.
Please note that these are the Unofficial Results.

There are 730 outstanding Absentee Ballots. This includes Uniformed and Overseas Voters and regular absentee ballots received in the mail that contain a timestamp of Monday, November 6 or earlier, and is received by Friday, November 17th by 4:30 P.M. Other ballots to be added into the Official Results includes any hospital voters or confined voters who cast their ballot on November 7th. There are also approximately 436 Provisional Ballots that may be eligible to be counted into the Official Results.

In the Unofficial Results, the following races may be eligible for an automatic recount:

Must be within 4 votes to require recount.
