It is the Order of the Court that any marriage license applicant who is unable to have the marriage ceremony performed within the required 60 days due to the declared public health emergency may be issued a new marriage license upon request. The Court will determine whether a new application will be necessary upon receipt of the request. Costs will be waived for the issuance of the new license unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

This Order is subject to Paragraph 13 of the Court's Journal Entry filed March 20, 2020, regarding the COVID-19 pandemic and the issuance of marriage licenses.
