**Issue**

**1 State Issue 1  
To require courts to consider  
factors like public safety when  
setting the amount of bail**

**Proposed Constitutional  
Amendment**

**Proposed by Joint Resolution of the  
General Assembly**

**To amend Section 9 of Article I of the  
Constitution of the State of Ohio**

The proposed amendment would:

- Require Ohio courts, when setting the amount of bail, to consider public safety, including the seriousness of the offense, as well as a person's criminal record, the likelihood a person will return to court, and any other factor the Ohio General Assembly may prescribe.
- Remove the requirement that the procedures for establishing the amount and conditions of bail be determined by the Supreme Court of Ohio. If passed, the amendment will be effective immediately.

**State Issue 2**

**To prohibit local government from allowing non-electors to vote**

**Proposed Constitutional Amendment**

**Proposed by Joint Resolution of the General Assembly**

**To amend Section 1 of Article V, Section 3 of Article X, and Section 3 of Article XVIII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio**

The proposed amendment would:

- Require that only a citizen of the United States, who is at least 18 years of age and who has been a legal resident and registered voter for at least 30 days, can vote at any state or local election held in this state.
- Prohibit local governments from allowing a person to vote in local elections if they are not legally qualified to vote in state elections. If passed, the amendment will be effective immediately.

**4 Fairport Harbor Public Library (2 pcts.)**

0.5 Mill Additional Levy – current expenses – 5 years – commencing in 2022, first due in 2023.

- 3 Willoughby-Eastlake City School District (49 pcts.)**  
2.44 Mills Renewal Levy – sum of \$4,745,186 – Emergency Requirements – 10 years – commencing 2022, first due in 2023.
- 5 Lake County (163 pcts.)**  
0.8 Mill Renewal Levy – senior citizen services or facilities – 5 years – commencing in 2022, first due in 2023.
- 6 Kirtland City (4 pcts.)**  
Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article VI, Section 1 of the Charter of the City of Kirtland, Ohio be amended to provide that the Council shall have the power to levy a municipal income tax at a rate not to exceed two and twenty-five hundredths percent (2.25%)?
- 6 Painesville City (11 pcts.)**  
1.47 Mills Renewal Levy – fire – 5 years – commencing in 2023, first due in 2024.
- 7 Painesville City (11 pcts.)**  
3 Mills Renewal Levy – Roads – 5 years – commencing in 2023, first due in 2024.
- 6 Willoughby City (18 pcts.)**  
0.5 Mill Renewal Levy – recreational purposes – 5 years – commencing in 2022, first due in 2023.
- 7 Willoughby City (18 pcts.)**  
1.5 Mills Renewal Levy – current expenses – 5 years – commencing in 2022, first due in 2023.
- 6 Timberlake Village (1 pct.)**  
4.2 Mills Renewal Levy – current operating expenses – 5 years – commencing in 2022, first due in 2023.

Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages and spirituous liquor be permitted for sale on Sunday by North Coast Fish House LLC DBA Lobster Pot (South wing East end only) an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit authorizing on/off premise sales who is engaged in the business of operating a neighborhood restaurant at 2749 Som Center Rd, Willoughby Hills, Ohio 44094 in this precinct?
- 8 Willoughby City Ward 6 Precinct C (1 pct.)**  
Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages be permitted for sale on Sunday by Aldi, Inc., Ohio, dba Aldi 87 an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit authorizing off-premise sales of wine and mixed beverages who is engaged in the business of operating a grocery store at 37100 Euclid Avenue, Willoughby, Ohio 44094 in this precinct?
- 6 Willowick City Ward 1 Precinct C (1 pct.)**  
Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages, and spirituous liquor be permitted for sale on Sunday by Lucid Willowick, L.L.C., (dba Sixth City Tavern) an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit authorizing on/off-premise sales of wine and mixed beverages, and on-premise sales of spirituous liquor who is engaged in the business of operating a bar/restaurant at 31222 Vine St, Willowick, Ohio 44095 in this precinct?
- 6 Grand River Village (1 pct.)**  
5 Mills Renewal and 3 Mills Increase Levy – current operating expenses – 5 years – commencing in 2023, first due in 2024.
- 6 Madison Village Precinct AA (1 pct.)**  
Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages be permitted for sale on Sunday by Ohio Springs Inc. d/b/a Sheetz 745 an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit authorizing off-premise sales who is engaged in the business of operating a convenience store at 560 River Street, Madison, Ohio 44057 in this precinct?
- 7 Madison Village Precinct BB (1 pct.)**  
Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages and spirituous liquor be permitted for sale on Sunday by Duffy’s Tavern and Restaurant an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit authorizing on/off-premise sales of wine and mixed beverages and spirituous liquor who is engaged in the business of operating a bar and restaurant at 60 W. Main St., Madison, Ohio 44057 in this precinct?
