Water Plant Maintenance

The Lake County Department of Utilities is accepting applications for the position of Water Plant Maintenance at our Aquarius Water Treatment Plant. Applicants must have a High School diploma or GED. A valid Ohio Driver's license with a safe driving record and a drug screening are required. Applicants familiar with maintenance and repair of large industrial pumps and motors, chemical feed pumps, gearboxes, mixers, compressed air systems, manual and electric actuating valves, pressure regulators, heating, ventilating and air conditioning systems and appropriate maintenance and repair logs is preferred. Familiarity with water treatment is preferable but not required. Good written and verbal communication skills; ability to have effective working relationships with fellow coworkers, public officials, the general public and regulatory agencies (OEPA) is preferred. This position will include physical labor, including working outdoors in all types of weather conditions. This position requires emergency call out response at all hours of the day and night including weekends and holidays. Salary range is \$20.50 - \$27.71 per hour.
