PUBLIC NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS SEALED PROPOSALS FOR LEGAL/TECHNICAL PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATING TO THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 (ARPA)

The Board of Lake County Commissioners requests sealed qualifications from interested and qualified organizations to provide professional legal and technical guidance regarding the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) funds. ARPA funds will be used to fund the professional consulting services contract.

The contract period for this program will begin on January 1, 2022 and expire on December 31, 2026, with the option for renewal for three additional one-year periods contingent upon availability of funds and offeror performance.
