<u>UTILITIES</u> – none.

JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES – none.

<u>COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR</u> – Mr. Jason Boyd updated the Board on the Painesville City Streetscape Project. He explained that a portion of the streetscape project was opened for use today and IT will be completed over the next couple of weeks. Painesville City "Party in the Park" will begin tomorrow, Friday, July 19th. The project budget and timeline are running as planned.

FINANCE - none.

<u>CLERK</u> –Commissioners Clerk, Ms. Jennifer Bell, stated that the next regular Commissioners Meeting will be held on Thursday, July 25th at 10:00 AM.

LEGAL - none.

OLD BUSINESS: - Commissioner Cirino stated that the Senate voted on HB 6 and it will move to the House. The House vote on H.B. 6 has been postponed until August 1. Once it is passed by the House, it will move to the Governor's office for immediate approval. The bill would keep Perry and Davis Besse Power Plants operating and will reduce electric rates for both residential and business consumers. Commissioner Cirino encouraged residents to call their State Representatives and ask for their support of the Bill.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: Commissioner Hamercheck stated that he attended the Historic Route 20 tour last week. He explained that the efforts for the branding of the Historic Route 20 project began in Lake County and that Lake County has 6 of these historic markers. The goal of this project is to bring attention to Historic Route 20 on both a local and a national level.

<u>OPEN TO THE PUBLIC</u>: Commissioner Cirino asked if anyone in the audience wished to address the Board.

Ms. Carol Pred of 6109 Stratford in Mentor, asked for clarification of item #13 on the agenda. Budget Director, Mr. Michael Matas, explained that this fund is a requirement by the Ohio Secretary of State in order to accept a one-time grant in the amount \$50,000 to specifically assist the Lake County Board of Elections with implementing priority items.

Mr. David Lima, 7774 Litchfield Drive in Mentor, asked if the renewable energy sections had been reintroduced into House Bill 6. Commissioner Cirino stated that he has not seen the final version of HB 6 but he has been made aware that there were several amendments made by the Senate.
