LAKE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MEETING MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER: Commissioner Troy called the meeting to order at 10:08 a.m., October 8, 2015.

<u>ROLL CALL</u>: Upon the roll being called, Commissioner Troy and Commissioner Moran were present. Commissioner Malecek was absent.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>: Upon a motion by Commissioner Moran, seconded by Commissioner Troy, the minutes of the regular meeting of September 22, 2015, and the minutes of the regular meeting of October 1, 2015, were approved as follows:

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC: Commissioner Troy asked if anyone in the audience wished to address the Board. Ms. Brenda Spadaro, 7612 Lake Shore Blvd., presented a petition in opposition to the vacation of a portion of Dock Road and she read the petition letter in its entirety citing that a total of 316 signatures were obtained opposing the vacation and two of these signatures are residents who previously supported the petition to vacate. Commissioner Troy stated that the Commissioners have all received a copy of the petition and there is a significant amount of signatures opposing the vacation of a portion of Dock Road. A public hearing was held on this road vacation last week. The Commissioners did not initiate this vacation but, by law, the Commissioners must follow the vacation process and request an Engineer's Report, which recommended the vacation of the road. The Commissioners are still taking comments on this issue and not prepared to make a decision at this time and the road will remain open.

Ms. JoAnn Dzopko, 1080 Edgewood in Madison, stated that the Engineer's Report probably carries a lot of weight but she thought that the road is a historical benefit and should not be vacated. It is used by many residents. Commissioner Troy stated that the reason the Engineer's Office rendered a decision is because they are required to by the ORC.
