WHEREAS, the Board of Lake County Commissioners deems that the amount of taxes which can be raised within the Ten-Mill Limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of Lake County in providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Sections 307.694, 307.85 and 5705.19(Y), authorize a Board of County Commissioners to levy a tax upon all of the taxable property in Lake County to pay all or a portion of the expenses for providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities; and

WHEREAS, an existing levy at the rate of eight-tenths (.80) of one mill for a period of five (5) years was placed on the ballot by resolution adopted by the Board of Lake County Commissioners on July 6, 2017, and was authorized by vote in the general election held on November 7, 2017, for the purposes set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code, Section 5705.191, authorizes a taxing authority to propose to renew an existing levy in its entirety at the rate at which it is authorized to be levied; and

WHEREAS, because it is necessary, it is the intent and desire of the Board of Lake County Commissioners to renew said existing levy authorized by this Board in 2017 and approved by the electorate on November 7, 2017 at the rate of eight-tenths (.80) of one mill in excess of the Ten-Mill Limitation for the same purpose of providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities for a period of five (5) years, commencing with and including a levy upon the duplicate and tax list beginning in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, Section 5705.03(B), the Lake County Auditor has certified to Lake County the total current tax valuation of Lake County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by said additional tax levy, a copy of said certificate being attached hereto, incorporated herein and made part of this resolution by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, in and for Lake County, Ohio, that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the Ten-Mill Limitation set forth in Ohio Revised Code, Section 5705.02, will be insufficient to provide adequate funds for the necessary requirements of Lake County, for the purpose of providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities.



A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Lake County for the purpose of providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities at a rate not exceeding 0.8 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to eight cents (\$.08) for each One Hundred Dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing with and including a levy upon the duplicate and tax list beginning in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.
