PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 2022 BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH IN LAKE COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the second most common cancer in women after skin cancer, and accounted for 29% of all cancers in women in Ohio in 2018; and

WHEREAS, breast cancer is about 100 times more common in women than men, 1 in 8 women will be diagnosed with the disease, and diagnoses increase as patients get older; and

WHEREAS, since early diagnosis strategies have been introduced, the five year survival rate for a breast cancer patient has greatly increased to nearly 90 percent; and

WHEREAS, in Ohio in 2019, 1,744 deaths occurred among women from breast cancer. Overall, breast cancer death rates among women decreased 11% from 2010-2019; and

WHEREAS, Breast Cancer Awareness Month serves as an opportunity to increase awareness of the disease and encourage individuals to have a plan to detect the disease in its early stages. The American Cancer Society continues to advise women to receive an annual mammogram screening upon reaching the age of 40.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners in and for Lake County hereby supports breast cancer research. The Board honors the women who have lost their lives to breast cancer and the women who are now courageously fighting the battle with breast cancer. We encourage all citizens to educate themselves about the importance of risk factors, early detection and treatment of breast cancer.
