

WHEREAS, each year, the Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials (APCO), an organization of more than 20,000 members engaged in the design, installation and operations of emergency response communications, sets aside a week in April to recognize telecommunicators county-wide for their role in the protection of life and property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Lake County Commissioners, with support from the Clerk of Courts, recently announced the Lake County Emergency Services Telecommunicators Scholarship Program that will be offered to qualifying students who are enrolled in Auburn Career Center's Emergency Services Telecommunicators Program; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to recognize and commend the Lake County Telecommunicators for the highly qualified and technical service they provide for the citizens of Lake County.
