#### DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

<u>UTILITIES</u> – Sanitary Engineer, Mr. Randy Rothlisberger, reported that the Old Town Kirtland Sewer Project is complete and the final assessment costs for residents in the area will be \$4,573.58 per unit. This assessment was reduced from the estimated \$28,500 per unit through grants and other funding methods. His department is in the process of verifying homeownership and the assessment letters will be mailed out within 2 weeks. Mr. Rothlisberger stated that the residents will have an option of paying the assessment in full, participating in a partial payment/payment plan, or having it placed onto their property tax bill. Commissioner Plecnik thanked Commissioner Beverage for the extra effort he put in finding additional funding sources to assist with the reduction of the assessments. Commissioner Beverage stated that he appreciates Commissioner Plecnik's sentiment and also thanked Mr. Rothlisberger, his staff, and Mr. Boyd for their assistance. He stressed that the more than \$28,000 assessment could have been catastrophic for some homeowners.

### JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES - none.
