JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES – Ms. Casar thanked her staff that will be working the Fair. She stated that today is Kids Day at the Fair and that Friday, July 25<sup>th</sup> is Senior Day. He explained that today they have begun to put the steel in place and reviewed the footage by explaining the basement, elevators, second stairwell and the 'front porch/steps' to the main entrance of the building. Sheriff Leonbruno stated that the goal is to have the roof completed by December.
