She further explained that with this annexation agreement they also have a revenue sharing agreement. COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR – Mr. Boyd presented some drone footage of the Public Safety Center and pointed out stage two of four on the steel sequencing and described how they will then proceed towards Jackson Street which will be stage three followed by looping back towards the Buildings and Grounds building to complete the steel sequence. The team will be planning a Steel Topping Ceremony in late October-early November. Mr. Boyd pointed out that one of the properties purchased by the County gave the owners until October 31 to vacate at which time they will raze that building to complete the entire site selection acquisition process. He stated that everything continues to progress as planned and, to make up time from the unidentified gas well in May they have been working on Saturdays. Last Saturday there were 23 ironworkers on site which was really good. At his weekly meeting, the executive in charge of the Project indicated that he would like them to continue working Saturdays until the snow flies.
