


Lake County Engineer – Seeking Public Input on the Middle Ridge Road (CR 22) Resurfacing Project in Madison Township, Ohio and Madison, Ohio



The Lake County Engineer is resurfacing and replacing storm sewers on Middle Ridge Road (CR 22) from Township Road (CR19) in Madison Township to SR 528 in Madison Village. The road surface is in poor condition. The roadway will be resurfaced to give the traveling public a smoother riding surface. Storm sewers will be removed and replaced in two locations within the project area.

Traffic will be maintained for all portions of the project.

The Middle Ridge Road improvement is scheduled for construction in 2024. The estimated construction cost is \$2.05 million.
