

**LAKE COUNTY OHIO  
CDBG - HOME FEDERAL GRANTS PROGRAMS  
PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE  
FISCAL YEAR 2019 ACTION PLAN**

Lake County is required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare an Annual Action Plan to govern the use of Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnership (HOME) funds. These funds must primarily benefit low and moderate income persons. Per HUD regulation and the Lake County Citizen Participation Plan two public hearings will be held by the Lake County Planning and Community Development (P&CD) office, serving as administrator of funds for the Lake County Board of Commissioners.

The mandatory CDBG - HOME pre-application briefing, serving as public hearing #1, will take place on Monday, April 15, 2019, from 10:00 A.M. to 12:00 noon, at the Lakeland Community College Holden University Center, 7700 Clocktower Drive, Kirtland, Ohio 44094. This meeting is mandatory for grant applicants. Attendance by grant writers on behalf of an applicant does not satisfy the applicant's attendance requirement. Due to limited seating, only one representative per organization would be appreciated. CDBG and HOME grant applications will be made available at this meeting along with information concerning eligible and ineligible activities. The meeting will feature a panel of speakers discussing tools and methods of achieving strategic goals, and showcasing examples of good practice using CDBG and HOME funds. Refreshments will be provided by The Coalition for Housing and Support Services of Lake County, Inc. Applications must be completed and returned by 4:00 P.M. on Monday, May 20, 2019 to the P&CD office.

During this development stage of the Annual Action Plan, the components of the Plan will be discussed and public comments will be solicited, including ideas regarding the community's needs, resources, and priorities.
