



## Introduction

Lake County Soil & Water Conservation District (SWCD) promotes the sustainability of Lake County's agricultural industries through education of local landowners, local officials and the citizenry. Lake County's unique soils, topography, geographic location and Lake Erie-driven climate support agricultural production that includes the heart of Ohio's wine industry, the nursery stock capital of the eastern United States and specialty fruit and vegetable operations.

With the support of The Cleveland Foundation, American Farmland Trust, Ohio State University Extension (OSUE), Ohio Wine Producers Association, Lake County Farm Bureau and the Lake County Development Council, Lake SWCD has undertaken a series of studies to assess the characteristics and economic impacts of the agricultural industries in Lake County between 2007 and 2013.

A Cost of Community Services Study for Madison Village and Township completed in March 2008 analyzed the true cost of land uses in Lake County. It demonstrated that agricultural lands have a net positive effect on local government budgets and that planning for the growth of a community should include a mix of commercial and industrial as well as farm and forested lands to help achieve fiscal balance.

Two economic impact studies were produced for the nursery and grape industries in the region, using producer surveys to collect data. *The Northeast Ohio Grape & Wine Economic Impact Study*, completed in November 2008 estimated the annual output of the industry as \$15 million with ripple effect impact of \$35.47 million to Northeast Ohioans' income. The *Results of the Lake County Nursery Industry Survey* completed in December 2009 estimated total annual sales of \$87.5 million.

The traditional agricultural producers and market growers were studied in 2012 with a mailed survey. Over 60 surveys were sent, but only 20 were received and of those, 4 respondents indicated that they no longer farmed. The intent was to interpret data from the producer surveys, but OSUE determined that an appropriate sample size was not obtained and the economic impact of the crop and livestock industries could not be adequately measured with survey data alone. As a result, IMPLAN, an economic input-output software model was used to estimate the economic impact of these industries. 2010 IMPLAN data was used, being the most recent data available at the time. *The Economic Impact Analysis of The Crop and Livestock Industries in Lake County Ohio for the Lake County Soil and Water Conservation District* was completed in February 2013. The crop industry was measured with 65 full-time equivalent jobs, an annual payroll of \$4.1 million and a total output of \$7,328,698. The livestock industry had 35 full-time equivalent jobs, an annual payroll of \$1 million, and a total output of \$4,013,569. The combined total output of the two industries is \$11.3 million.

In August 2013, the IMPLAN model was used to measure the total overall economic impact of all the of Lake County's agricultural industries combined. In the following study, The *Economic* 

Impact Analysis of the Crop, Livestock, Viticulture, and Horticulture Industries in Lake County, Ohio for the Lake County Soil and Water Conservation District, the crop, animal/livestock, viticulture and horticulture sectors were run through IMPLAN to determine overall economic impact for all of Lake County's agricultural industries **using the same units of measurement**.

When comparing the results of the separate studies, please note that when IMPLAN is run on one particular industry and then run on the combined industries, the data are not directly comparable due to different reactions of the variables with one another.

The codes used by the IMPLAN model are aligned to the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) codes. NAICS codes were first used locally in the *Results of The Lake County Nursery Industry Survey* to put agricultural economic impacts into the traditional NAICS industrial format. NAICS codes provide appropriate economic multipliers to help ensure that the United States Census Bureau has access to accurate information. Using NAICS codes more clearly expresses the economic contribution agriculture provides to our local and state economies and enables local decision makers to more fairly evaluate the economic impact of Lake County's agricultural industries in comparison to other business sectors.

The table below summarizes the combined economic impact of the crop, livestock, viticulture and horticulture industries in Lake County, Ohio using IMPLAN. The total value produced by Lake County agriculture is \$151.4 million.



## **Executive Summary**

Lake County, situated in the northeast portion of the State of Ohio, and bounded by Lake Erie to the north had a population of 230,000 according to the 2010 census data. The County contains traditional rural and suburban areas with future residential development viewed as a potential constraint to future agricultural use. In fact, there are over 15,000 acres of farmland with 240 farms with the average farm size being 63 acres. The census data also indicate that the total cash receipt was \$49,750,000 with each farm receiving \$207,293.



Over the past six years, Ohio State University Extension and Lake County Soil and Water Conservation District (Lake SWCD) have partnered to learn more about the economic impact of agriculture in Lake County. Lake SWCD and the Ohio Wine Producers Association worked with Ohio State University Extension to conduct a survey gathering data from the grape and wine industry in 2008. The following year, a survey was conducted to ascertain data from the Nursery Sector. Lastly, in 2011, a survey was developed to learn about the economic impact of the Crop and Animal/Livestock Industry. Reports for the three surveys are available at the Lake County Soil and Water Conservation District Headquarters.

While it is necessary to gather data from locally developed surveys, it is also as important to use an economic input-output (I-O) model to measure overall economic impact.

## **IMPLAN Impact Model**

This Executive Summary estimates the impact of the Lake County Crop, Animal/Livestock, Viticulture, and Horticulture Sectors in Lake County, Ohio using IMPLAN, an economic inputoutput modeling software designed to describe relationships among the various sectors in an economy and estimate the impacts of changes in those sectors. The model captures indirect and induced impacts that occur from direct investment using 2011 IMPLAN data (the most recent available). The analysis is based on the premise that sectors are linked; a change in one sector will create change in others. This summary analyzes the crop, animal/livestock, viticulture, and horticulture activities listed below that account for the total economic impact in Lake County, Ohio. Summary Analysis of IMPLAN Data indicates the following:

- 1. An estimated 1,431 annual fulltime equivalent jobs and an estimated annual payroll of \$98,566,163 are supported by crop, animal/livestock, viticulture, and horticulture activities in Lake County.
- 2. The estimated total Value Added to the Lake County economy from these industries is \$95,268,994.
- 3. The estimated total Output to the Lake County economy from these industries is \$151,401,145.

Using input/output modeling, we can estimate the extent to which the Lake County crop, livestock, viticulture, and horticulture industries contribute to other employment (measured in full-time equivalents), output, income (measured in dollars) and total value added.

Impact terms for purposes of this study are defined below:

- The <u>direct effect</u> is felt when dollars are spent for the operation of Crop, Livestock, Viticulture, and Horticulture industries in Lake County, Ohio.
- The <u>indirect effect</u> occurs as Ohio businesses provide goods and services used by the above industries in Lake County, and when these businesses, in turn, make additional purchases from Ohio businesses.
- The <u>induced effect</u> occurs as workers in the directly and indirectly affected industries receive income that they then use to purchase consumer goods and services from other businesses in Ohio.
- The <u>total effect</u> to operate the above industries in Lake County is the sum of the direct, indirect, and induced effects.

# Appendix

## Full Time Equivalent Employment (FTE)

Full-time equivalent employment is the number of full-time equivalent jobs, as determined by total hours worked divided by average annual hours worked in fulltime jobs.

## Labor Income

Labor Income IMPLAN is the total payroll cost of the employee paid by the employer in addition to proprietor (owner) income. This includes, wage and salary, all benefits (e.g., health, retirement, etc.) and employer- paid payroll taxes (e.g., employer side of social security, unemployment taxes, etc.).

## Output

Output represents the value of industry production. In IMPLAN these are annual production estimates for the year of the data set and are in producer prices.

Manufacturing	output = sales +/- change in inventory
Service Sector	output = sales
Retail and wholesale trade	output = gross margin (not gross sales)

## **Total Value-added**

Total value added is the contribution of each private industry and of government to the nation's output, or GDP. It represents total output of an industry or establishment (which consists of sales or receipts and other operating income, commodity taxes, and inventory change) less the cost of its intermediate inputs (which consist of energy, raw materials, semi-finished goods, and services that are purchased from domestic industries or from foreign sources).
