What: Check in at the solid waste facility scale house to drop off the following universal wastes for **FREE***:

- Aerosol Cans
- Antifreeze
- Lithium-Ion Batteries
- Lead-Acid Batteries
- Fertilizer
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Mercury-Containing Thermometers
- Mercury-Containing Thermostats
- Mercury-Containing Switches
- Latex Paint
- Oil-Based Paints
- Oil-Based Wood Stains
- Solvents
- Paint Stripper
- Paint Thinner
- Pesticides
- Motor Oil
- **No Propane, Acetylene, Fire Ext.**
- **No Gasoline**
